(A) When it comes to sports, there are many recent examples of bad sportsmanship. There was a pitcher on a professional baseball team who made angry, extreme gestures when the umpire called his pitch a ball rather than a strike. There was a Wimbledon tennis player who was fined for throwing his racket, yelling at spectators, and insulting the chair umpire. There was a Little League baseball umpire who ejected players from a certain team for speaking in a language besides English, which is not a rule violation.

Why does bad sportsmanship happen? (B) Perhaps it is because the players feel mental pressure to win at all costs. In sports, especially at the professional level, the pressure to win is overwhelming. Certainly, players who don't win enough get cut from teams, and coaches whose teams don't win enough get fired. Still, it is regrettable to see these incidents of bad sportsmanship.

On the other hand, we can also find recent examples of good sportsmanship. Shohei Ohtani of the Los Angeles Angels is a case in point. When a player for the other team broke his bat when hitting a pitch, Ohtani picked up the broken pieces and returned them to that player after the play was over. Ohtani's good sportsmanship reminds me of the words of a famous American sports writer.
